By The Commission:

Matthew Frandsen has petitioned the Commission for leave to intervene in this docket. Mr. Frandsen proposes to intervene “to provide information in the form of historical power consumption in Utah.” Consumer interests are directly represented in this docket through the participation of the Committee of Consumer Services, the Utah Ratepayers Alliance, and through the Division of Public Utilities. Mr. Frandsen has not indicated that his interests will not be adequately represented through these current parties in this docket; nor that he has interests, unique to himself, which cannot be pursued through the existing parties. We note that Mr. Frandsen has opportunity to provide his information as a public witness without the need for his formal intervention in this docket. Public Witness days have been scheduled for August 1, 2001 (on revenue requirement matters), and October 3, 2001 (for cost of service and spread of rates/rate design matters). Mr. Frandsen may present his information, whether sworn or unsworn, at the Pubic Witness Day(s).
