DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSIONS

The Commission supports the implementation of cost effective DSM in Utah. However the Commission recognizes that the proposed increase in the DSM Rider will collect more money than the currently authorized programs will cost on a going forward basis. Therefore the Commission finds that it is reasonable to investigate what DSM Rider rate best serves the public interest. Therefore we provide notice at this time of a technical conference to be held on July 14, 2009, at 9:30 a.m., in Room 401 at the Heber M. Wells building to begin the process of determining the appropriate rate for the DSM Rider at this time.
