SYNOPSIS

Tad R. Olson having petitioned for Commission relief from Rocky Mountain Power's proposed termination of utility service for nonpayment of applicable charges, at premises where life support equipment is allegedly located, and the parties reaching agreement on a payment plan for arrearages, the matter is dismissed.

By The Commission:

On January 2, 2009, TAD R. OLSON (hereafter "Respondent") filed his petition seeking relief from a proposed termination of the utility service at Respondent's home, which is allegedly the location of life support appliances. After notice of hearing, Rocky Mountain Power and Respondent appeared and represented they had reached agreement on payment of the arrearage amount. A copy of the agreement was presented and received by the hearing officer. The hearing officer, having been fully advised in the premises, now enters the following proposed

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- This matter is dismissed.

• Pursuant to Utah Code 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, agency review or rehearing of this order may be obtained by filing a request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission fails to grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a Petition for Review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any Petition for Review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code 63G-4-401 through -403 and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
