To Whom It May Concern:

We strongly support the proposal to remove GSS and EAC rates from the Questar Gas Company's tariff. Natural gas service has clearly benefited rural Utah. We appreciate the accommodations made several years ago to bring bean gas to Mountainview Mushrooms. However, the various arrangements made to cover the cost of bringing that service to rural Utah have resulted in some areas receiving economic-development advantages over others.

GSS and EAC rates were tools that allowed rapid expansion of a critical service. But these arrangements favored only the fastest growing communities. Those communities have been able to join Utah's economic mainstream faster. Higher rates in Fillmore only keep us from catching up, or even competing on an equal advantage basis. For the benefit of the whole state, it's time to level the playing field. Removing the extra charges from our rates will help accomplish this.

Economic development in rural Utah will benefit the entire state. It will take pressure off the Wasatch Front and Washington County. It will provide more options to businesses and industries considering relocating to Utah. It will provide additional jobs and income beyond the agriculture and the service sector. More competitive natural gas rates will provide the jumpstart we need.

The minimal cost of this jumpstart was the rationale originally used by the legislature to help some communities receive gas service. Because of 1998's HB180, all Questar Gas customers pay a few cents extra every month to cover the costs of taking gas service to Panguitch, Cedar Fort and Brian Head. This is a good example of the type of cooperation and compromise we are requesting. We urge the Public Service Commission to approve the proposal.
