Dear Commissioners: Pursuant to Utah Code § 63-46b-12, an aggrieved party may file, within 30 days after the date of this Report and Order, a written request for rehearing or reconsideration by the Commission. I use natural gas in my vehicle and home. I prefer natural gas appliances and vehicles because of the clean energy to efficiency ratio and because it is mostly domestic.

- I already pay more for equipment and service of both uses (especially the vehicle).
- I care about helping clean up the air along the Wasatch front.
- I care about reducing our dependence on imported oil.
- I feel that the natural gas we use in our homes and especially in our vehicles should not be artificially cost controlled like oil. If the price of natural gas for vehicles is significantly increased people won't have enough incentive to use it. And we will continue in an economical, environmental and national security downward direction.
- I would like to see us clean up our act for the planet and our children.
- Raising the price of natural gas needs to be looked at from all angles.
- I hope the commission will reconsider the initial increases it plans and find a more reasonable solution.
