I am extremely disappointed with the decision of the PSC and their ruling to increase the price of natural gas for vehicles. We paid \$4000.00 - \$8000.00 additional dollars to purchase or convert our vehicles so that we can be, inconvenienced by a lack of fueling pressure, limited driving range due to size of fuel tank and limited use of vehicle since if you leave the state there are no fueling stations open to the public in Idaho, Colorado and Wyoming.
