I am seriously concerned about the PSC's decision to raise the cost of natural gas for vehicles. The benefits to the state in reduced emissions and clean air (and reduction or elimination of costly EPA mandates to attain acceptable air quality) by far outweigh the small cost to maintain the current price structure. Reduced cost of fuel was certainly one of the factors (along with trying to do my little GREEN part) that drove me to purchase a NG vehicle, and given the current difficulty in even finding a station where you can actually FILL your tank, increasing the cost will certainly drive me to abandon it.
