I am concerned about the Public Service Commission's recent decision to raise natural gas rates for NVG/CNG users in Utah. My husband and I commute to our jobs in South Davis Co. We live in Morgan because of conditions on the Wasatch Front. Docket No. 07-057-13 will completely nullify our efforts to maintain reasonable commute costs while contributing to what we felt was a greater cause in reducing the emissions from our commutes, and lowering our contribution to America's dependence on foreign oil. The reasoning behind this decision appears flawed and not in context with our goals as Utahns, to lead the way in protecting our planet and preserving our country. I found information on the Internet indicating that Questar's profit margin is 26%, as compared to the large oil companies margin of 10-11%. How does this make sense?
