BACKGROUND

This matter is before the Commission on Questar Gas Company's (Questar) Application for Approval of Revised Tariff Sheets for Demand Side Management Programs, specifically for Section 2.12, Therm-Wise Multi-family Rebates Program and Section 2.15, Therm-Wise Weatherization Program of their Utah natural Gas tariff PSCU 400.

Questar filed its revised tariff sheets on May 11, 2009, pursuant to a Commission order of March 31, 2009 in this same docket. The Division of Public Utilities (Division) filed its Recommendation on May 13, 2009. The Division reviewed the tariff sheets and the changes as ordered by the Commission. It concluded that the Commission-approved changes were incorporated in the tariff sheets with an effective date of May 2, 2009. The Division recommended approval of the revised tariff sheets.

Based on the tariff sheets submitted by Questar and the Division's Recommendation, the Commission orders as follows:

1. The revised tariff sheets for demand side management programs, specifically for Section 2.12, Therm-Wise Multi-family Rebates Program and Section 2.15, Therm-Wise Weatherization Program of Questar's Utah natural gas tariff PSCU 400, are approved;

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2. Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-4-301 and 54-7-15, an aggrieved party may request agency review or rehearing of this Order by filing a written request for review or rehearing with the Commission within 30 days after the issuance of the Order. Responses to a request for agency review or rehearing must be filed within 15 days of the filing of the request for review or rehearing. If the Commission does not grant a request for review or rehearing within 20 days after the filing of a request for review or rehearing, it is deemed denied. Judicial review of the Commission's final agency action may be obtained by filing a petition for review with the Utah Supreme Court within 30 days after final agency action. Any petition for review must comply with the requirements of Utah Code §§ 63G-4-401, 63G-4-403, and the Utah Rules of Appellate Procedure.
