PROCEDURAL HISTORY, DISCUSSION, AND FINDINGS

On January 30, 2006, 01 Communications of Utah, LLC (“Petitioner”), requested the Commission approve its petition to discontinue all local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services and cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“Certificate”). On February 7, 2006, the Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) filed a memorandum recommending cancellation of the Certificate.

As Petitioner does not currently provide telecommunications service to any customers within the State of Utah, no detriment to the public interest appears and the Commission hereby issues the following

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that:

- The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, issued March 8, 2000, to 01 Communications of Utah, LLC, be, and it is, cancelled and annulled effective the date of this Order.
- Any person aggrieved by this Order may petition the Commission for review within 20 days of the date of this Order. Failure so to do will forfeit the right to appeal to the Utah Supreme Court.
