Judge Arredondo-

Please pardon the informality of this email instead of a formal pleading, but I wanted to let you know that Qwest and Verizon believe they have reached a settlement in principle last Friday afternoon. However, because of client authority requirements and procedures, and because it may take a few days to iron out the final deal points, it may be a few days before the parties are certain that they have indeed reached a settlement.

In any event, as Your Honor will recall, you issued an order on Wednesday, June 10, 2009 granting Qwest's motion to compel certain call detail record data and ordering that Verizon produce the data on Monday, June 15, 2009 (today), and that Qwest would have until this Thursday, June 18, 2009, in which to file its reply testimony.

In light of the settlement in principle, both Qwest and Verizon jointly desire a one-week extension of these two dates (but not the July 8, 2009 hearing date) in order to obtain final client approval of the settlement and to prepare the necessary documentation. In the event the case does not settle, there would still be sufficient time between Qwest's reply testimony on June 25th and the hearing on July 8th if Your Honor grants this request.

Finally, given that Verizon's data is due today, and it does not want to be out of compliance with the order, the parties have agreed to email Your Honor and make this joint request.
