By Request filed July 28, 2008, Tel West Communications LLC (Tel West) seeks cancellation of its certificate previously issued October 13, 2000, in Docket No. 00-2311-01. Since issuance of its certificate, Tel West has experience decline numbers of customers; as of June of 2007, Tel West has had no customers in Utah. On August 27, 2008, the Division of Public Utilities (Division) provided its Memorandum, summarizing its review of the Request and Tel West's operations. The Division notes that Tel West has complied with Administrative Rule R746-350, to exit the Utah market and Tel West is no longer registered as a business entity for operations in Utah. The Division recommends the Commission grant Tel West's request and cancel its certificate.

Based upon the foregoing, the Commission will grant the request and cancel Tel West's certificate of public convenience and necessity.

Wherefore, it is hereby ORDERED the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to Tel West Communications LLC on October 13, 2000, is cancelled and Tel West no longer has authority to operate as a public utility in the State of Utah.
