<b>Status Report</b>	<b>Monday, January 25, 2010.</b> The Division shall submit a status report informing the Commission of the parties' progress in resolving any dispute relating to the application. If it is anticipated that a evidentiary hearing will be needed to resolve any dispute, the status report shall recommend a schedule for the filing of testimony in preparation of the April 2010 hearing.

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<b>Hearing</b>	A hearing on the Company's application, if needed, will be conducted by the Administrative Law Judge of the Public Service Commission on <b>Monday April 5 and Tuesday April, 6, 2010</b> . It will commence each day at <b>9:00 a.m., Fourth Floor Room 451</b> , Heber M. Wells State Office building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.

Participants attending by telephone should then call the Public Service Commission five minutes prior to the conference to ensure participation.
